

ATTENTION Essex County College graduates:

Qualify for a FULL TUITION SCHOLARSHIP to complete your Bachelor's degree at Berkeley College!

Students who have graduated with an Associate's degree from Essex County College (ECC) and attend either the Newark or Woodland Park location of Berkeley College are eligible for a fully paid scholarship that would cover their tuition and fees balance after all federal/state grants and other scholarships have been applied.*

To be eligible, students must:

- Have an Associate's degree from ECC and be accepted for admission to Berkeley College.
- Begin at Berkeley College in Newark or Woodland Park, NJ in the Spring 2012 quarter or Summer 2012 quarter as a full-time student. The Spring quarter begins April 2, 2012 and the Summer quarter begins July 2, 2012.
- Attend either the Newark or Woodland Park location until degree completion.
- Remain continuously enrolled for the first academic year. Once the student has completed the academic year, the student may take a quarter off without losing the scholarship upon return.
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress to be eligible for the scholarship in the second academic year.
- Meet all federal and state grant application deadlines when reapplying for a new financial aid year.
- Sign an agreement acknowledging awareness of the eligibility requirements.

How the Transfer Scholarship works:

The Transfer Scholarship covers the tuition and fees balance after all federal/state grants and other scholarships have been applied. Books and supplies are not covered. The award will vary for each award period based on eligibility. The maximum award granted for each award period will not exceed the total cost of tuition and fees.

The process:

1. Apply to Berkeley College, Newark, NJ or Woodland Park, NJ through the Admissions Office. The college will waive the application fee.
2. Upon acceptance, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and answer the additional questions required to receive the NJ Tuition Assistance Grant (TAG).
3. Financial Aid will assess the student's eligibility and generate an award notification with the Transfer Scholarship.
4. Admissions will schedule a registration appointment with Advisement.
5. Advisement will evaluate the student's transcript and provide a course schedule.

Example of award eligibility:

Federal Grants	\$ 5,550
State Grant	\$ 4,500
Balance	\$11,700
Berkeley College Transfer Scholarship	\$11,700
Balance Due to Berkeley College	\$ 0
