- Guests must enter through the Citizens Tower or the designated doors in the M&M's Tower.
- Graduates, remember to bring your cap & gown as well as any honors cords or honors society stoles you may have received.
 - o If you do not have your cap and gown, you will be able to get one after you check-in (first-come-first-served, while supplies last).

Arena Bag Policy

Not all bags are permitted inside the Prudential Center. The ONLY exceptions are...

- Bags up to 12" x 14"
- Medical or childcare bags that are larger may be permitted after being X-rayed.

Bags that do not meet these expectations must be returned to the guest's vehicle or stored in a Prudential Center supplied locker. at the guest's expense. Lockers are located outside the M&M's Tower, and Lafayette Street entrances.

Arena Cashless Policy

Cash will NOT be accepted at concession stands, retail locations, or the Box Office. Pay with a debit or credit card using tap to pay, chip or swipe, or mobile payment, including Apple Pay and Google Pay. For guests needing to convert cash to a card, Reverse ATMs are available with no fees by sections 1, 14, 125, and inside the Box Office Lobby.
